The information also acts as a checklist for the applicant so that they have all of the necessary information to apply for the program, and if they are eligible for flexible subsidy assistance. The information is considered non-sensitive. While no assurances of confidentiality are pledged to respondents, HUD generally discloses this data only in response to a Freedom of Information request.
