Penobscot Indian Nation in Old Town, Maine will receive a Rural Housing and Economic Development grant in the amount of \$399,581. This support for innovative housing and economic development activities grant will be used to prepare a site evaluation and development plan for elderly assisted housing. These efforts will result in the construction of 17 housing units and rehabilitation of 10 housing units. Local and private resources have been leveraged in the amount of \$458,838. Partners for the project include: Coastal Enterprises, Inc. and the State of Maine.
