SUBJECT: Tribal Consultation on FY 2022 CoC Program Competition and Funding Opportunities

Dear Tribal Leader:

On May 25, 2021, the Office of Special Needs Assistance Programs (SNAPS), working with the Office of Native American Programs (ONAP), held a second consultation to provide additional information regarding the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program and the FY 2021 CoC Program Competition in which Indian Tribes and Tribally Designated Housing Entities (TDHEs) were eligible to participate for the first time. The competition opened on August 18, 2021, and applications were due on November 16, 2021.

On January 11, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time, SNAPS and ONAP will conduct a Tribal consultation session to provide information and solicit feedback from Indian Tribes regarding the FY 2022 CoC Program Competition and registration process as well as the following funding opportunities:

- Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP); and
- Unsheltered Homelessness and Rural Homelessness NOFO

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 National Emergency, HUD will again host a virtual Tribal consultation via webinar to provide Tribal leaders the opportunity to provide comments to HUD. Tribal leaders and their TDHEs are highly encouraged to participate.
