

HUD's Agency Priority Goals (APG) for Fiscal Years 2012 and 2013

The FY12-FY13 APGs are as follows:

Goal 1: Strengthen the Nation's Housing Market to Bolster the Economy and Protect Consumers

- Assist homeowners who are at risk of losing their homes due to foreclosure (Strategic Plan Measure 1a)
- Reduce the average residential vacancy rate in NSP2 investment areas (M3a)

Goal 2: Meet the Need for Quality Affordable Rental Homes

- Increase the number of families housed through HUD's affordable rental housing programs (M5a)

Goal 3: Utilize Housing as a Platform for Improving Quality of Life

- Reduce the number of homeless families (M6a)
- Reduce the number of chronically homeless individuals (M6b)
- Reduce the number of homeless veterans (M6c)

Goal 4: Build Inclusive and Sustainable Communities Free from Discrimination

- Increase the number of cost-effective energy and green retrofits of public, assisted, and other HUD supported affordable homes (M13)
