

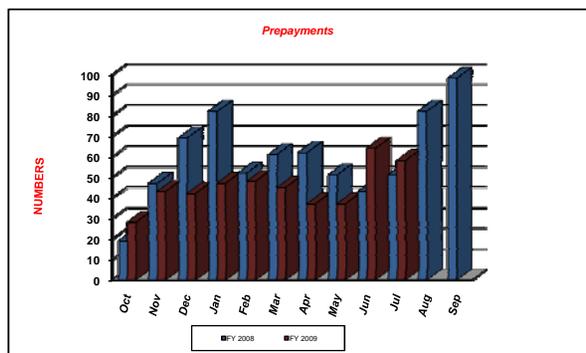

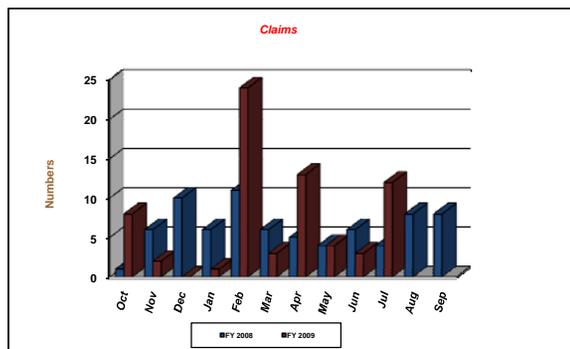

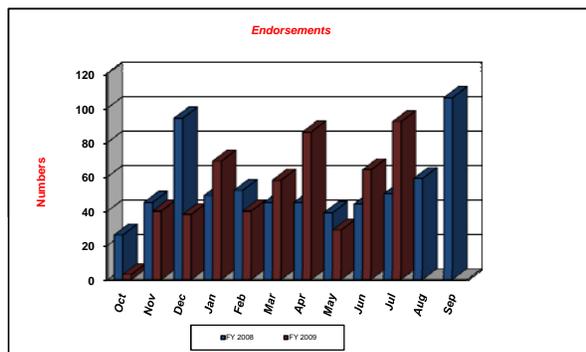

**Monthly Comparisons of FY 2008 and FY 2009\***



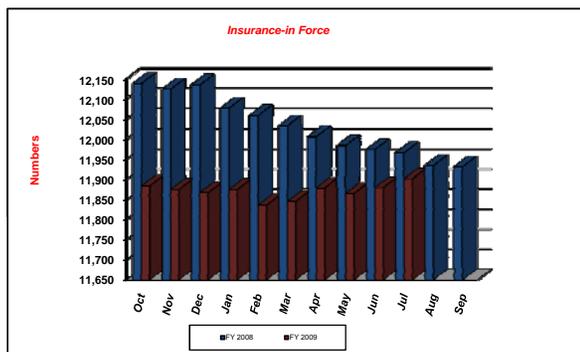

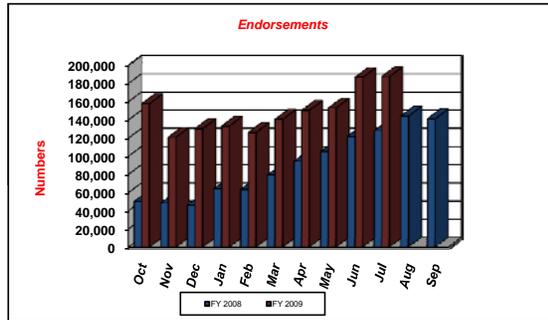

**Monthly Comparisons of FY 2008 and FY 2009\***



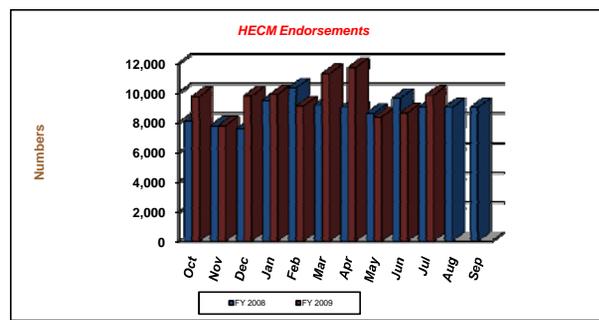

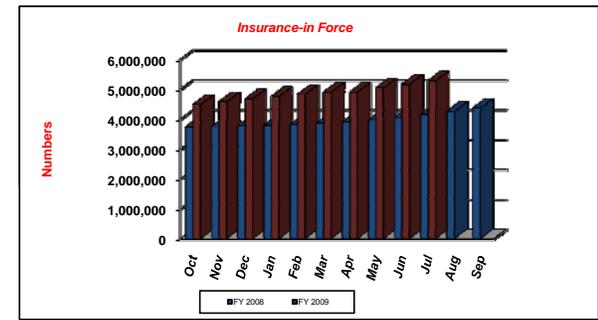

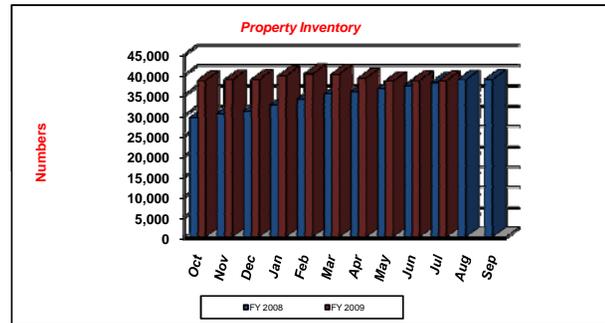

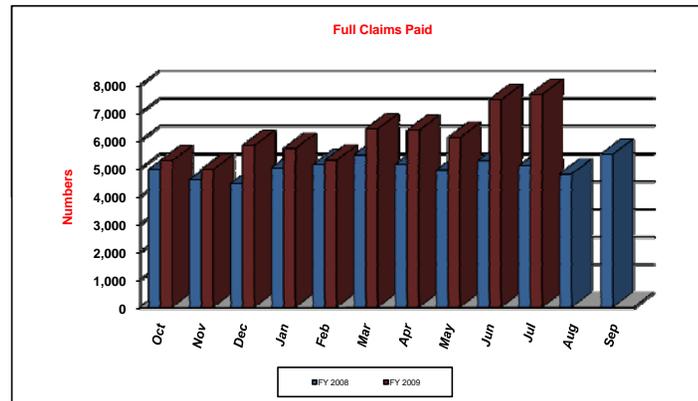
### Monthly Comparisons of FY 2008 and FY 2009\*

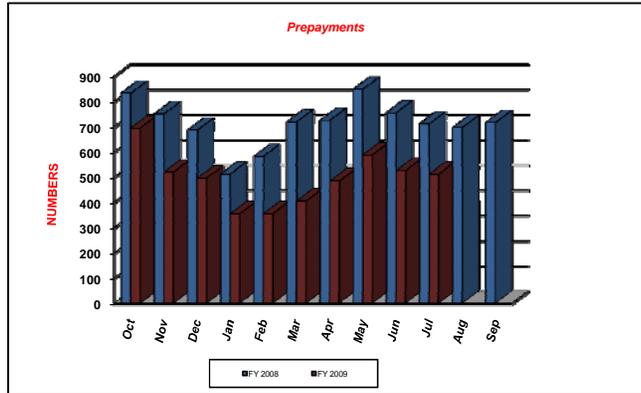

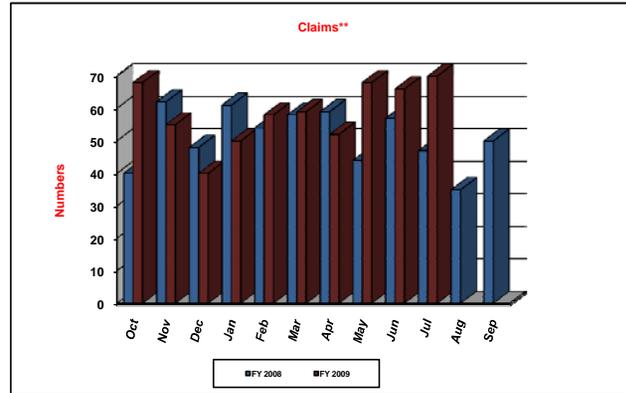

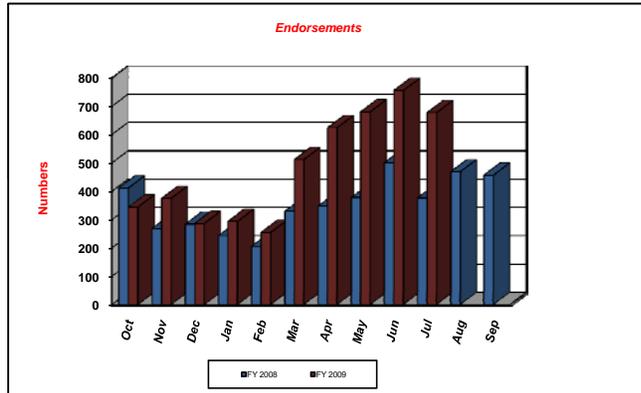
**Title I Insured Portfolio**  
**Monthly Comparisons of FY 2008 and FY 2009\***



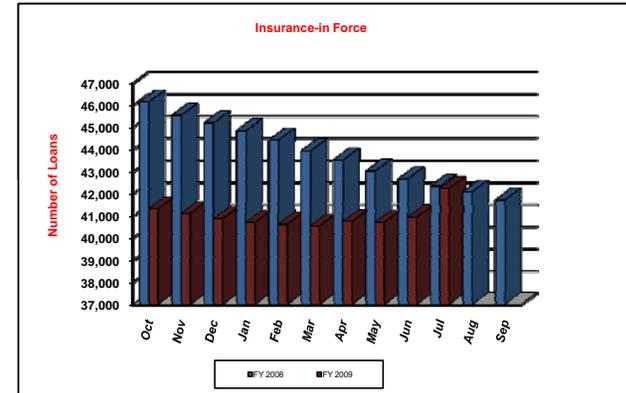

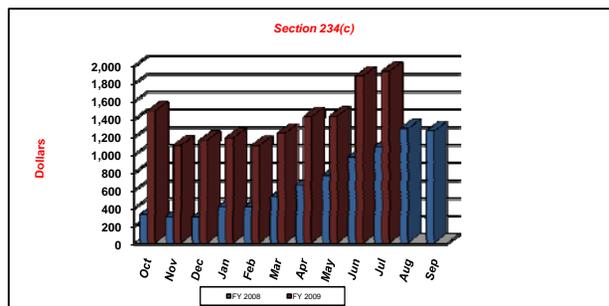

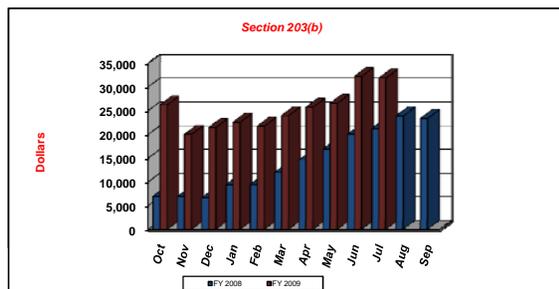
**Commitments (Dollars are in Millions)**  
**Monthly Comparisons of FY 2008 and FY 2009\***



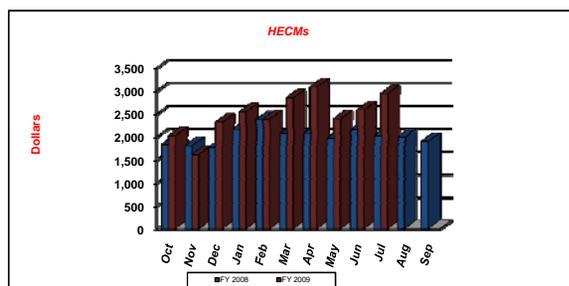

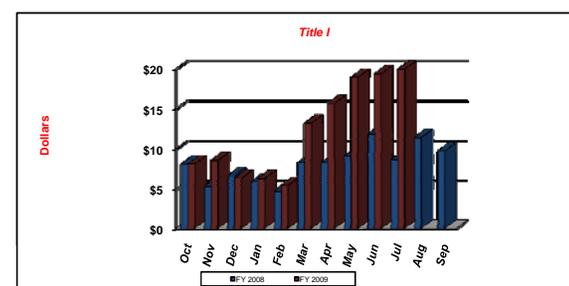

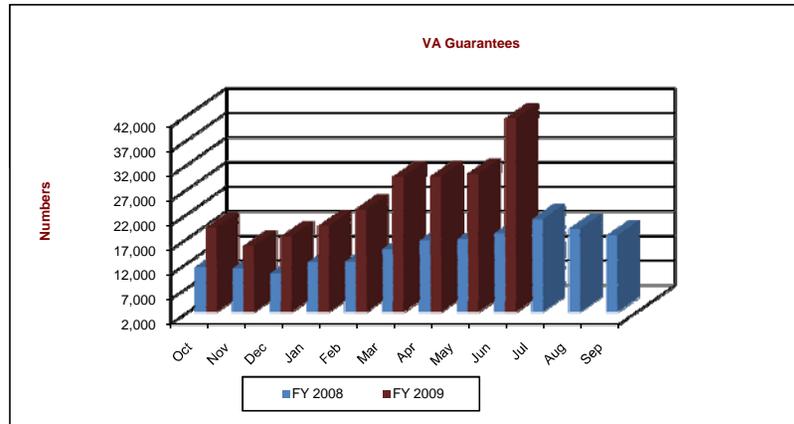
