DESIGN GUIDELINES

Judges will look for posters that best reflect the spirit and celebration of community pride in Neighborhood Networks centers. Create a theme that truly represents your Neighborhood Networks center and how it helps the community. Judges will look for neatness as well.

RULES

1. Each center may submit one poster entry.
2. The contest is open to Neighborhood Networks center youth ages 8–14.
3. Use a minimum of three colors.
4. Use color markers, paints, crayons, or colored pencils.
5. Poster size must be 11x14 inches.
6. Label the back of your poster with the center name, address, city, state, center director's name and telephone number, and child's name and age.
7. Entries must be received by May 9, 2003. Mail your poster to NN Poster Contest, 2277 Research Boulevard, MS 5J, Rockville, MD 20850. Do not fold your poster. Use cardboard to support your poster and keep it safe during mailing. We're sorry, but artwork will not be returned.
