

## Mark your calendar for FSS Job Fair

**t**he Family Self-Sufficiency Program's (FSS) annual job fair will be held on Friday, September 20<sup>th</sup> from 2:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. at CHAC offices located at 1000

South Wabash. The job fair gives participants the opportunity to submit resumes and applications to not just one, but several companies who are actively looking for new employees—all in the span of a few hours. Fairs make the job search process much easier, by eliminating much of the

travel and footwork, often involved in looking for a job.

Last year, 13 employers and more than 200 FSS participants attended the fair. The employers represented all sectors of the business community—from entry-level service jobs to manufacturing and professional positions. Participants were able to talk with recruiters, submit resumes, and fill out applications. Some participants

## Secretary Mel Martinez's visit gives CHAC's homeownership program a boost

**U**S Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Secretary Mel Martinez stopped in the Pilsen community for a press conference to promote homeownership among minority families. He was joined by representatives from CHAC, the Chicago Housing Authority, Freddie Mac, Fannie Mae, and the City of Chicago.

Last year, under Secretary Martinez's leadership, HUD adopted new rules that facilitated the creation of homeownership programs nationwide, by allowing participants in the voucher program to use their voucher to pay a portion of their mortgage, the same way they use it to offset their rent. Under CHAC's Choose to Own Program, families can use the voucher to subsidize their mortgage for up to 15 years.

For CHAC, one of the highlights of the homeownership press conference was the opportunity for William Riley, Executive Director of CHAC and Crystal Mack, a participant in Choose to Own, to meet Secretary Martinez. Crystal is one of 61 families in CHAC's

even scheduled interviews right on the spot.

There are some specific steps you can take now to prepare for the job fair. Start by reviewing and updating your resume. If you are a member of FSS and need assistance preparing or revising your resume, attend our job club meeting this month. It's also a good idea to prepare 3 or 4 good references. You'll need them when filling out applications. Make sure that all the contact information such as the company, title or position, address and phone number is current. Finally, when you receive your invitation, determine which employer(s) you want to visit. Then do your homework. Learning about the companies and their products and services will help you relate your skills and experience to the specific needs of each company.
