

## WHAT'S NEW IN EIV RELEASE 7.0 FOR PIH USERS?

Below is a list of new functionality in EIV Release 7.0 for PIH users:

Function	Description
<b>Income Discrepancy Report</b>	
Income Discrepancy Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New option to search by Project for Public Housing programs and display the header table statistics corresponding to the selected project</li> <li>• Capability to download into printer-friendly Excel any of the Income Discrepancy Report.</li> </ul>
<b>Income Information</b>	
By Head of Household	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the Summary Report tab, add new column for Relationship Code on the Member List table.</li> <li>• On the Income Report tab, the income information for live-in aide members will not be displayed.</li> </ul>
By Reexamination Month	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New option to select a Project, for Public Housing programs and generate reports pertinent to the selected project.</li> <li>• On the Report Summary page, the links to all the 5 reports (Income, Income Discrepancy, Failed Verification, No Income and New Hires) will be activate, when "ALL" is selected from the Reexamination Month, and the record count is less than 1000. Otherwise, only the summary table (Number of Households, Number of Members for each report) shall be displayed, without active links to the individual reports.</li> <li>• On the Income Report – Summary Report, No Income Report and New Hires Report - Summary Report page, add the Unit Code column and sorting capability on this column.</li> </ul>
New Hires Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New option to select a Project, for Public Housing program and generate reports pertinent to the selected project.</li> </ul>
<b>Verification Reports</b>	
Multi-Subsidy Tenant Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New option to select a Project, for Public Housing program and generate reports pertinent to the selected project.</li> <li>• Correct the count of members with multiple subsidies. If a member is in 2 (or more) households in the same PHA, the member shall</li> </ul>

	be counted only by 1.
Identity Verification Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New option to select a Project, for Public Housing program and generate reports pertinent to the selected project.</li> <li>• Display the following percentages: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Percentage of household members who are Not-Verified.</li> <li>- Percentage of household members who are failed.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Existing Tenant Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New capability to search by SSN and verify information if the given person is already receiving housing subsidies in any PIH or Multi-family programs.</li> </ul>
<b>Audit Reports</b>	
Tenant Data Access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New optional entry field for the User ID. If a value is entered into field, the Tenant Data Report shall be filtered to display tenant data access by the User ID only.</li> </ul>
PHA Usage Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New selection option for HUD HQ, State, HUB, FO, TARC and PHA in the initial selection page and generate corresponding report for the selected option.</li> <li>• Capability to download into Excel any of the PHA Usage Report except for the PHA level.</li> <li>• Printer-friendly formatting option for each report.</li> </ul>
HUD Usage Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New report that would list each HUD User (at HQ, HUB, FO, TARC levels) and display whether the user accessed EIV in the last 30 days or within the last 180 days.</li> </ul>
