

Public Housing EHS Certification Form Available

The Office of Public Housing requires all Exigent Health and Safety hazards be mitigated immediately.

- Public Housing Authorities will receive an e-mail within 48 hours of the inspection notifying the PHA of the existence of Exigent Health and Safety deficiencies. PHAs are required to repair all EHS items and fax or send the signed certification form attesting that all corrections have been made to the local PIH field office within 10 days after the inspection. HUD may follow up with you to verify the correction of these deficiencies. A copy of the required certification form is attached for your use.

Multifamily EHS Certification Form Available

The Office of Housing requires all Exigent Health and Safety hazards be mitigated within 3 business days.

- The inspector records all health and safety hazards identified during the inspection. If observed during the inspection, certain health and safety deficiencies require immediate repair or remediation. Before leaving the property the inspector will give you or your representative a written notice that lists specific instances where these items were observed and ask you or your representative to sign acknowledging receipt of said notice. HUD requires the Owner/Agent to certify repair or remediation of these deficiencies within 3 business days of notice. A copy of the required certification form is attached for your use.
