HUD and Artificial Intelligence

Artificial Intelligence (AI)

- Communities are eager to use tools that may expand their capacity
- Consider risks & rewards before implementation
- Ensure privacy and responsible use-
 - Private Personal Information (PPI) should <u>not</u> be inputted to tools like ChatGPT, Gemini, or Copilot
 - Similarly, be vigilant of tools that might collect PPI where they should not. For example: Al notetaking in case conferencing meetings
 - Include community members and front-line staff in decision-making about AI use and be prepared to help educate them







(AI) Artificial Intelligence

- Al tools are good for some tasks but can be poor for others
- Tasks these tools are good at include drafting fundraising emails, generating Excel formulas, and helping with programming
- They may be <u>unreliable</u> with tasks requiring human judgement (like prioritizing folks for service), or that rely on current information (like, 'where is the new emergency shelter I heard about?')

Artificial Intelligence (AI) – Prompt Examples

Acceptable

"Here are 5 years of <u>aggregate</u> program information and outcomes data -- help me understand lessons or elements that might help me improve the outcomes of the program"

Unacceptable

"Here is a CSV of all the people waiting for services - tell me who I should serve first"










TRANSFORMING OUR APPROACH TO HOMELESSNESS

Temporary Shelter + Inadequate Rehousing Exits




2015-2020 – 3 X increase in unsheltered homelessness 45% increase in homelessness overall







Trends in Unsheltered Homelessness

Dallas and Collin Counties Point-in-Time Count (2015-2020)







Point-in-Time Count (2020-2024)
















Pathway to 50% Reduction in Unsheltered Homelessness
