DISMISSAL ORDER

This matter is before the Court upon Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a debt allegedly owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").¹

On December 4, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* requesting dismissal of this matter without prejudice because Petitioner has entered into a voluntary repayment agreement with HUD's Financial Operations Center. HUD notes that it reserves the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, should Petitioner fail to pay the subject debt in accordance with the terms of the repayment agreement.

For good cause shown, HUD's motion is **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.

¹ While this case was pending, a lapse in appropriations occurred that resulted in the longest federal government shutdown in history and the closure of this Court from October 1, 2025, to November 13, 2025. Due to this closure, a *Notice and Stay of Proceedings* was issued on October 1, 2025, staying all matters pending before the Court, including the instant matter. The Court has now reopened, and the stay of this matter is therefore **LIFTED**.
