ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 31, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").¹

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter, because Petitioner filed a Chapter 13 Bankruptcy in the Southern District of Florida, on March 14, 2025. That Chapter 13 Bankruptcy is currently active. As a result, the Secretary moves to dismiss this proceeding without prejudice and reserves the right to seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, e.g., Administrative Offset, and may resume Administrative Wage Garnishment activities in the future should facts reveal that Petitioner is justly indebted to HUD.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
