ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 1, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On September 29, 2025, the Secretary moved for dismissal of this matter on the grounds that Petitioner's debt was paid in full to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, and the related funds were transmitted to HUD on May 29, 2025.¹

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**.

¹ However, while the motion was under consideration, a lapse in appropriations for the federal government resulted in the closure of this Court from October 1, 2025, to November 13, 2025. The Court has now reopened, and the stay of this matter is therefore **lifted**.
