

**RENEWAL OF COMPUTER MATCHING AGREEMENT**

**BETWEEN**

**U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES  
ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN AND FAMILIES  
OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT**

**AND**

**U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**

*Verification of Employment and Income and Analysis*

U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Data Integrity Board #2315

The Privacy Act of 1974, as amended by the Computer Matching and Privacy Protection Act of 1988, provides that a matching agreement shall remain in effect only for such period, not to exceed 18 months, as the Data Integrity Board of the agency determines is appropriate. Within three months prior to the expiration of such an agreement, the Data Integrity Board of the agency may, without additional review, renew the matching agreement for a current, ongoing matching program for not more than one year if: (1) such program will be conducted without any change; and (2) each party to the agreement certifies to the Board in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the agreement. 5 U.S.C. § 552a(o)(2)(C) and (D).

The following match meets the conditions for renewal.

- I. TITLE OF THE MATCHING PROGRAM:** “Verification of Employment and Income and Analysis” – HHS #2315
- II. RECIPIENT AGENCY:** U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
- III. SOURCE AGENCY:** U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE)
- IV. PURPOSE AND LEGAL AUTHORITY FOR THE MATCHING PROGRAM**

The purpose of the matching program is to provide U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) with new hire, quarterly wage, and unemployment insurance information from OCSE’s National Directory of New Hires to assist HUD in verifying the employment and income of individuals participating in certain rental assistance programs. HUD may also use the information, after the removal of personal identifiers, to analyze the employment and income reporting of those participants.

Subsection 453(j)(7) of the Social Security Act provides the legal authority for conducting the matching program, specifically 42 U.S.C § 653 (j)(7).

**V. EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF THE MATCHING AGREEMENT**

The effective period of the matching agreement is March 9, 2024, through September 8, 2025.

**VI. EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF THE RENEWAL OF THE MATCHING AGREEMENT**

Upon execution of the certification by both parties and approval of the Data Integrity Boards of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and HUD, the effective period shall be from September 9, 2025, through September 8, 2026.

**VII. AGENCY CERTIFICATION**

As designated authorized representatives of the source and recipient agencies participating in the matching program, we certify that (1) the parties to the agreement complied, and will continue to comply, with the current agreement (2) the matching program will continue without any change.
