Subject: Extension of Effective Date for Departmental Policy for Addressing Radon in the Environmental Review Process for Tribes, Tribally Designated Housing Entities, and Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

1. Purpose:

This notice extends the effective date of Notice CPD-23-103, which established a departmental policy for addressing radon in the environmental review process for Tribes, Tribally Designated Housing Entities (TDHEs), and Department of Hawaiian Home Lands.

2. Background:

Notice CPD-23-103 clarified that radon must be considered in the contamination analysis for 24 CFR Parts 50.3(i) or 58.5(i), as applicable, and detailed how environmental review preparers consider radon in the HUD environmental review. The notice became effective 90 days after issuance for non-Tribal recipients and January 11, 2026, for TDHEs, and Department of Hawaiian Home Lands recipients.

3. Revision of Date:

The effective date of Notice CPD-23-103 is hereby extended by 120 days - from January 11, 2026, to May 11, 2026 - for Tribes, TDHEs, and Department of Hawaiian Homelands.
