

## HUD AWARDS \$990,000 TO FIGHT COVID-19

*Grants were awarded to support and promote fair housing nationwide.*

As part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES Act) (Public Law 116-136, approved March 27, 2020), The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded \$990,000 (see grant chart below for full list of recipients) under its *Fair Housing Initiatives Program (FHIP)* Education and Outreach Initiative (EOI) Component in supplemental grant funding for creating and disseminating fair housing education and outreach materials as a result of COVID-19.

HUD's FHIP EOI CARES Act grant supports education and outreach activities during this national emergency. The education and outreach activities these organizations conduct also help to educate the public, housing providers, and local governments about their rights and responsibilities under the Fair Housing Act.
