ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ELECTION AND
TERMINATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

A Charge of Discrimination under the Fair Housing Act, 42 U.S.C. § 3601 *et seq.*, was filed in this matter on June 11, 2010 by The Secretary, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 3612(a), on June 18, 2010, *Southwest Fair Housing Council, the person on whose behalf the charge was brought by the Secretary*, made a timely election to have the claims asserted in the charge decided in a civil action heard by a United States district court, rather than in an administrative hearing proceeding.

Therefore, this administrative proceeding is hereby terminated and the Secretary shall authorize the commencement and maintenance of a civil action on behalf of the aggrieved person(s) in a United States district court as provided by 42 U.S.C. § 3612(o).
