## CORRECTED ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ELECTION AND TERMINATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

A Charge of Discrimination under the Fair Housing Act, 42 U.S.C. § 3601 *et seq.*, was filed in this matter on June 11, 2010 by The Secretary, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
