## **RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On March 12, 2010, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss this action against Petitioner. The Secretary states that this case "has already been adjudicated by the Office of Appeals and a decision in favor of the Secretary was entered on June 23, 2009. Secretary's Motion to Dismiss and Allow Offset, ¶2. On March 23, 2010, this Office held the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss in abeyance and ordered Petitioner, on or before April 23, 2010, to show cause why the this case should not be dismissed and why offset should not be imposed forthwith. Petitioner failed to comply with the March 23, 2010 Order. Accordingly, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. It is

**ORDERED** that this case is DISMISSED, with prejudice, and judgment is entered in favor of the Secretary, to allow administrative offset of any payments otherwise due to Petitioner from the federal government. The Stay of Referral entered by this court on February 24, 2010 is hereby VACATED.
