ORDER FOR DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE

The Secretary has filed the *Secretary's Statement* in this case. In Petitioner's *Request for Hearing*, Petitioner stated that it was difficult for her to obtain documents due to the office closures caused by the Covid health crisis. Petitioner is expected to address the argument and evidence set forth in the *Secretary's Statement* completely and with specificity. Many of these documents can be requested and obtained from the lender involved in this case. By now, Petitioner should have made every effort to obtain these records, including scanned records, photos, etc., in addition to Petitioner's own personal records. If additional time is required, Petitioner may request an extension of time. However, since much time has already elapsed, Petitioner is required to go forward with her documents in response to the *Secretary's Statement*, within the next several weeks. If Petitioner seeks to prove financial hardship, she must present documentary evidence consisting of proof of payment of necessary household expenses, in addition to household income. Petitioner may also file an affidavit or sworn declaration in support of her argument and evidence in this case. It is

ORDERED that, <u>on or about January 22, 2021</u>, PETITIONER SHALL FILE documentary evidence to prove that Petitioner is not indebted to the Department in the amounts claimed by the Secretary, or that repayment would require undue financial hardship.
