RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 17, 2021, the Secretary filed her *SECRETARY'S MOTION TO DISMISS* on the grounds that Federal Housing Administration policy now calls for the non-enforcement of "callable events" on HUD notes that arise as a result of foreclosure. The alleged debt in this case arose as a result of foreclosure, and the Secretary, accordingly, moves to dismiss this case "with prejudice." *Id*, at ¶3. Without objection, the *Motion to Dismiss*, is GRANTED.

The Secretary also filed the *SECRETARY'S MOTION TO CORRECT CLAIM NUMBER* on December 17, 2021, stating that the correct claim number in this case should be recorded as "721013708." Without objection, this motion is also GRANTED. It is

ORDERED, that the appeal in this case is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Stay of Referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury initially imposed on November 19, 2021, is hereby **VACATED**.
