
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT, on March 15, 2022, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss (Motion)* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because "The Secretary has determined that collection of Petitioner's debt by means of administrative wage garnishment is not possible at this time, as HUD has confirmed that Petitioner is self-employed." Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

HUD, however, reserves the right to seek collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment should Petitioner obtain employment. The stay of referral issued on January 10, 2022 by *Notice of Docketing* is hereby VACATED shall it be determined in the future that the subject debt may be collected by means of administrative wage garnishment upon Petitioner's re-employment.

The matter of HUDOHA No. 22-VH-0069-AG-051 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
