ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT, on May 23, 2022, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because "Petitioner was involuntarily separated from her last employment and has not yet been in her current employment for twelve months." Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment, should Petitioner's employment status change in the future.

The stay of referral issued on March 24, 2022 by *Notice of Docketing* is hereby **VACATED** shall it be determined in the future that Petitioner's employment status has changed.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 22-VH-0135-AG-093 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
