ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL


NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT, on October 14, 2022, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because "HUD has determined that Petitioner is no longer employed by her former employer. HUD is unable to determine Petitioner's employment status at this time." Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall reserve the right to resume debt collection activities, by means of administrative wage garnishment or via alternative means such as administrative offset, should Petitioner's financial circumstances improve in the future.

The stay of referral issued on August 18, 2022 by *Notice of Docketing* is hereby VACATED shall it be determined in the future that Petitioner's financial circumstances have otherwise improved.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 22-VH-0193-AG-123 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
