ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 24, 2023, the Court received Petitioner's *Hearing Request* wherein Petitioner disputed the amount of the debt claimed by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"). Thereafter, the Court ordered the Secretary and Petitioner to file documentary evidence in support of their respective positions. The Secretary complied with the Court's order and filed a *Corrected Secretary's Statement* and supporting evidence on July 13, 2023. Petitioner did not comply or otherwise respond.

Having not received a timely filing from Petitioner, the Court again ordered Petitioner to file documentary evidence in support of her position by March 11, 2024. Petitioner also failed to comply with that *Order* resulting in the Court ordering Petitioner to show cause as to why her appeal should not be dismissed. Again, Petitioner did not comply or respond.

When a party fails to comply with an order of the Court, the Court may impose a sanction that reasonably relates to the severity and nature of the failure. 24 C.F.R. § 26.4. If a party fails to prosecute or defend an action, dismissal of the matter or a decision against that party may also be imposed. <u>Id.</u> at § 26.4(d).

To date, Petitioner has not complied with the Court's orders or otherwise produced evidence in support of her position that the amount of the debt is incorrect. Accordingly, this matter is **DISMISSED**, and the stay of proceedings issued on May 25, 2023, is hereby **VACATED**.
