ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 14, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's *Request for Hearing* wherein Petitioner explains she is not responsible for the alleged debt to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter because HUD determined that the property lien associated with the debt in the amount of \$69,700.78 has been released. As a result, the Secretary reports that HUD has ceased collection activities against Petitioner and will no longer seek to collect the subject debt via administrative offset or otherwise.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
