ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 14, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's *Hearing Request* wherein Petitioner acknowledged receiving the mortgage assistance that resulted in this alleged debt being owed. However, Petitioner requested that HUD not attempt to enforce the debt against him, because he was ordered to vacate the property pursuant to a divorce decree and his exspouse subsequently sold the property.

On December 15, 2024, the Tribunal ordered Petitioner to file documentary evidence in support of his position that the debt should not be enforced against him. Said documentary evidence was due by January 17, 2024. Petitioner did not comply or otherwise respond.

Having not received a timely filing from Petitioner, the Tribunal ordered Petitioner to show cause as to why his appeal should not be dismissed. Again, Petitioner did not comply or respond.

When a party fails to comply with an order of the Tribunal, the Tribunal may impose a sanction that reasonably relates to the severity and nature of the failure. 24 C.F.R. § 26.4. If a party fails to prosecute or defend an action, dismissal of the matter or a decision against that party may also be imposed. Id. at § 26.4(d).

To date, Petitioner has not complied with the Tribunal's orders or otherwise produced evidence in support of his position that the debt should not be enforced. Accordingly, this matter is **DISMISSED**, and the stay of proceedings issued on December 15, 2023, is hereby **VACATED**.
