## **ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On January 11, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter because Petitioner has provided a copy of her weekly pay statement demonstrating that she does not meet the minimum threshold set forth at 31 C.F.R. §285.11 and is therefore not eligible for administrative wage garnishment. Accordingly, the Secretary is no longer pursuing a garnishment of Petitioner's wages. However, the Secretary states that HUD may seek collection of this debt by administrative wage garnishment at such time in the future that Petitioner's financial situation improves.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
