ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On February 7, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this matter on the grounds that Petitioner and HUD have reached an agreement for repayment of the debt and HUD has ceased all efforts to collect the debt by Administrative Wage Garnishment. The Secretary adds that, should Petitioner fail to comply with the terms of their agreement, HUD may resume Administrative Wage Garnishment activities.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
