ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On February 20, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal as Petitioner no longer disputes the existence of her debt to HUD and, instead, intends to repay it. In support, the Secretary provided an email from Petitioner stating such. The Secretary adds that HUD reserves the right to resume collection efforts should Petitioner fail to pay the debt that is the subject of this proceeding.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is dismissed without prejudice. The stay or referral in this matter is **VACATED**.
