Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Withdraw Appeal* and *Motion to Dismiss* are hereby **GRANTED**. The stay of referral in the *Notice of Docketing* issued on April 8, 2024, is hereby VACATED.

The matter of HUDOHA No. 24-VH-0202-AO-035 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
