ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES before the Court a *Statement that Petitioner's Debt is Past Due and Legally Enforceable and Motion to Dismiss* ("Motion"), filed by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD" or "Secretary") on June 10, 2024. HUD moves to dismiss, without prejudice, the action to collect the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because of Petitioner's limited income. HUD maintains that the Petitioner is liable for the past due debt. Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the Motion is **GRANTED**.

The Secretary shall retain the right to seek administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner at such time in the future should Petitioner's wages increase. It is ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on May 10, 2024 is hereby VACATED.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 24-VH-0250-AG-158 is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
