ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES before the Court a *Motion to Dismiss* (“*Motion*”), filed by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD” or “Secretary”) on July 22, 2024. HUD moves to dismiss, without prejudice, this action to collect the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because HUD has been unable to confirm that Petitioner is currently employed. HUD maintains that Petitioner is liable for the subject debt. Upon consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

The Secretary retains the right to seek administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner at such time in the future that Petitioner becomes employed. The Secretary also retains the right to seek collection of the subject debt via administrative offset. The stay of proceeding issued on July 3, 2024, is hereby **VACATED**.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 24-VH-0305-AG-195 is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
