
**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On March 26, 2025, this Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to seek repayment of a debt allegedly owed to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") via administrative wage garnishment.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this matter on the grounds that Petitioner and HUD have entered into a written Payment Agreement regarding the subject debt. The Secretary adds that, should Petitioner fail to comply with the terms of the Payment Agreement before the debt has been repaid, HUD retains the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection.

For good cause, the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* is **GRANTED**; and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The stay imposed on March 26, 2025, is **VACATED**.
