ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 26, 2025, this Tribunal received Petitioners' requests for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to seek repayment of a debt allegedly owed to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") via administrative wage garnishment.

The Secretary now moves to dismiss this matter without prejudice on the grounds that garnishment would cause Petitioners financial hardship. The Secretary adds that, should Petitioners' financial circumstances improve, HUD retains the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection.

For good cause, the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**; and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The stay imposed on March 27, 2025, is **VACATED**.
