ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 18, 2025, this Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to seek repayment of a debt allegedly owed to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") via administrative wage garnishment.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal, without prejudice, of this matter on the grounds that garnishment of Petitioner's wages at this time would cause Petitioner financial hardship. The Secretary adds that, should Petitioner's financial circumstances change, HUD retains the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection.

For good cause, the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**; and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The stay imposed on April 23, 2025, is **VACATED**.
