**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On May 13, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to seek repayment of a debt allegedly owed to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") via administrative wage garnishment.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal, without prejudice, of this matter on the grounds that Petitioner and HUD have entered into a written Debt Resolution Program Repayment Agreement ("Agreement") regarding the subject debt. The Secretary adds that, should Petitioner fail to comply with the terms of the Agreement before the debt has been repaid in full, HUD retains the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection.

For good cause, the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* is **GRANTED**; and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The stay imposed on May 19, 2025, is **VACATED**.
