
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 4, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt allegedly owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On September 8, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Statement that Petitioner's Debt is Past Due and Legally Enforceable and Motion to Dismiss* presenting evidence that Petitioner owes a debt arising out of three promissory notes he executed in HUD's favor, but acknowledging that Petitioner has been involuntarily terminated from his employment. Under applicable regulations, Petitioner will not be eligible for wage garnishment until such time that he has been reemployed continuously for at least 12 months. See 31 C.F.R. § 285.11(j). As a result, HUD seeks to dismiss this matter without prejudice and reserves the right to seek collection by means of administrative wage garnishment when Petitioner becomes eligible for wage garnishment in the future.

For good cause shown, the Secretary's request for dismissal is **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
