
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 18, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to seek repayment of a debt allegedly owed to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") via administrative wage garnishment.

The Secretary now moves to dismiss this matter without prejudice and vacate the stay of collection because Petitioner has entered into a voluntary repayment agreement with the U.S. Department of the Treasury regarding the debt that is the subject of this proceeding. The Secretary adds that HUD may again seek collection of the debt from Petitioner by administrative wage garnishment if Petitioner defaults on the repayment agreement.

For good cause shown, the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* is **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The stay imposed on August 20, 2025, is **VACATED**.
