DISMISSAL ORDER

On September 2, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to garnish Petitioner's wages to collect a debt allegedly owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this case without prejudice on grounds that Petitioner has entered into a voluntary repayment agreement with the U.S. Department of the Treasury. The Secretary states that HUD reserves the right to resume debt collection activities in the future if Petitioner fails to pay the subject debt in accordance with the terms of the repayment agreement.

For good cause shown, the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
