
ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPEAL

On February 11, 2025, this Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a debt allegedly owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"). On February 13, 2025, this Tribunal issued a *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral*.

On March 24, 2025, the parties submitted a *Joint Motion to Withdraw Appeal* stating that the parties have a shared understanding that, through a reconciliation of the parties' records, the parties will be able to reduce materially (if not eliminate) the number of at-issue debts – with the parties already achieving a substantial reduction of such debts. The parties also state that the reduction in debts will be best served by the parties focusing on their ongoing reconciliation efforts rather than ensuring compliance with the Tribunal's *Order*. Lastly, if any debts remain, HUD will issue a new administrative offset notice. Therefore, the parties request that the Tribunal grant their joint request to withdraw appeal.

For good cause, the parties *Joint Motion to Withdraw Appeal* is hereby **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
