**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**


On March 7, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On April 11, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* stating that Petitioner entered into a voluntary Repayment Agreement with HUD, whereby Petitioner has promised to make payments in an agreed amount as specified in the Agreement until the subject debt owed to HUD has been repaid in full.

As a result, HUD moves to dismiss the instant Administrative Wage Garnishment proceeding without prejudice and retains the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection against Petitioner, should she fail to pay pursuant to the Agreement, or should future circumstances frustrate or terminate the Agreement and Petitioner's debt to HUD remain outstanding.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
