
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 7, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On April 11, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* stating that the Secretary has determined that, although the debt owed to HUD is past due and legally enforceable, garnishment of Petitioner's wages at this time would create financial hardship. As a result, HUD moves to dismiss the instant Administrative Wage Garnishment proceeding without prejudice and retains the right to again seek administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner should Petitioner's financial circumstances change in the future.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
