
**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On March 20, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On April 24, 2025, HUD filed *HUD Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* stating that HUD was unable to confirm that Petitioner is currently employed and therefore will not seek collection by means of administrative wage garnishment at this time. As a result, the Secretary moves to dismiss this matter without prejudice and reserves the right to again seek administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner should Petitioner become re-employed and eligible for wage garnishment in the future.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
