ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 20, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On August 6, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* stating that Petitioner sent an email to HUD counsel stating that she wishes to dismiss her request for a hearing because she no longer contests the legal enforceability of the debt. As a result, HUD supports Petitioner's request to dismiss her hearing request and will notify the U.S. Department of the Treasury upon dismissal and lifting of the stay.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
