ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Petitioner, through counsel, sent correspondence dated November 1, 2024, which was deemed to be a *Request for Hearing*. The correspondence requested review of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's decision to seek repayment of an alleged debt by offsetting federal payments due to Petitioner.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter because Petitioner's debt to HUD has been paid in full. Specifically, the Secretary explains that, on July 5, 2024, First American Title Insurance Company submitted a payment to HUD in the amount of \$34,571.44, which fully satisfied Petitioner's debt.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
