ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 3, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

HUD now moves for dismissal of the matter, because it has been unable to confirm that Petitioner is currently employed.¹ HUD requests that the dismissal be without prejudice so that it may seek collection of the subject debt via alternative means, i.e., Administrative Offset, and may resume Administrative Wage Garnishment activities in the future should Petitioner resume employment.

For good cause, HUD's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice. The stay of referral in this matter is **VACATED**.
