ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 29, 2025, this Tribunal issued a *Decision and Order* finding the debt that is the subject of this proceeding is past due and enforceable against Petitioners. Thereafter, Petitioners requested reconsideration of the *Decision and Order*.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this matter on the grounds that Petitioners have entered into a voluntary repayment agreement with the Department of Treasury wherein an initial payment of \$772.79 would be withdrawn from Petitioners' account on January 29, 2025. The Department of Treasury's records further indicate that two consecutive payments, each in the amount of \$772.79, have been made towards satisfying the debt. The Secretary adds that, should Petitioners fail to comply with the terms of the Agreement, HUD may pursue all legally available means of debt collection against Petitioners.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
