ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 23, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On May 20, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* stating that Petitioner and HUD have entered into a Debt Resolution Program Repayment Agreement ("Agreement"), executed by HUD on May 15, 2025, whereby Petitioner has promised to make monthly payments in the agreed amount until her debt has been repaid in full. As a result, HUD moves to dismiss the instant Administrative Wage Garnishment proceeding without prejudice and retains the right to pursue all legally available means of debt collection against Petitioner, should she fail to pay pursuant to the Agreement, or should future circumstances frustrate or terminate the Agreement and Petitioner's debt to HUD remains outstanding.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
