ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 23, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this matter on the grounds that HUD considers Petitioner's debt to be satisfied. Specifically, HUD states that the U.S. Department of Treasury received payment from Petitioner in the amount of \$29,960.13 on May 6, 2023, in connection with its Offer in Compromise program. However, Petitioner failed to fulfill all the requirements of the Offer in Compromise program, which resulted in subsequent wage garnishments. Because the subsequent payments made on the account were cause by Petitioner's failure to complete the Offer in Compromise program, HUD is unable to refund them. HUD notes that there is a remaining balance of \$165.43 on Petitioner's account as of May 30, 2025. However, HUD still considers this indebtedness to be satisfied and is "proceeding with account closeout."

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
